Menhinick and Little concerning the preparation of a comprehensive zoning plan for Brunswick and Glynn County including the most feasible or practical means of employing a consultant and a resident planning director, and the use of existing maps, plans, etc.

It was determined that the Joint Planning Commission would receive from interested planning consultants proposals for rendering the services to be required, the cost thereof, and suggested methods of accomplishing a comprehensive zoning plan with appropriate ordinances.
