A lengthy discussion took place concerning the qualifications offered by several municipal planning consultants with whom the Board either held interviews or from whom proposals had been received.

It was thereupon determined that the Commission would confine further consideration to those municipal planning firms located in the State of Georgia and presumably more intimately acquainted with the appropriate zoning statutes and Georgia laws pertaining to municipalities and political subdivisions.

It was proposed that inasmuch as a personal interview had been had with the firm of Menhinick and Little of Atlanta, representatives of the firm of Hill and Adley Associates of Atlanta and Sidney Carter of Augusta would be invited to appear before the Commission for interviews.

A discussion took place concerning the appropriate title for the individual who would become the administrative head for the comprehensive zoning plan for Brunswick and Glynn County.

A motion was made by Mr. Compton, seconded by Mr. Davis, and unanimously adopted that the official title of "Planning Director" be designated for the individual who will ultimately serve as head of the City - County comprehensive zoning plan.
