

REGULAR MEETING

APRIL 14th, 1959

9:00 A. M.

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PRESENT: Chairman M. A. Knight, James D. Compton, Fred T. Davis, Neal Gale, Cormac McGarvey, W. Wright Parker and R. F. D. Paulk

ABSENT: C. J. Dubs

ALSO PRESENT: City Manager H. Bruce Lovvorn, County Administrator Howard J. Sears, and County Attorney Edward B. Liles

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Motion by Mr. Compton, seconded by Mr. Gale, was unanimously adopted to approve minutes of meetings held March 10th, 1959, at 9:00 A. M., and March 16th, 1959, at 8:30 A. M.

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The Commission reviewed the proposal made at its request by Hill and Adley, Planning Consultants of Atlanta. It was noted that Mr. Adley suggested that perhaps the best procedure or sequence to follow was the employment of a Planning Director who would assist the Commission in contracting for consulting services.

After a discussion of applications before the Commission for the job of Planning Director, it appeared to be the consensus that Mr. Robert H. Doyle of Atlanta possessed the most favorable qualifications. Thereupon the City Manager, Mr. Lovvorn, was directed to attempt to contact Mr. Doyle by telephone and arrange for a personal interview before the Commission.

It was then agreed that the City Manager and County Administrator would arrange a time for an interview with Mr. Doyle and notify all members of the Commission.

(The members of the Commission were ultimately notified that Mr. Doyle would be available for an interview at 9:00 A. M. on Monday, April 20th.)

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A discussion then ensued pertaining to the application for Federal assistance in accomplishing the comprehensive zoning plan which would include urban renewal studies.

Motion by Mr. Compton, seconded by Mr. Parker, that the City Manager and County Administrator be authorized to place with the appropriate agency of the State of Georgia such application or preliminary request as might be necessary to place the City of Brunswick in line for Federal assistance through State coordination at such time as the proposed zoning plan would be ready for this particular phase of a community planning study.

Unanimously adopted.
