Motion by Mr. Parker, seconded by Mr. Paulk, was unanimously adopted to approve minutes of meetings held April 14th, 1959, at 9:00 A. M., and April 20th, 1959, at 9:00 A. M.

The Commission was advised that Mr. Robert H. Doyle had accepted the Commission's offer of employment as Planning Director of The Brunswick - Glynn County Joint Planning Commission in accordance with the terms heretofore approved by the Commission.

The Commission was informed of the contents of a letter from Hill and Adley Associates, Planning Consultants of Atlanta, which in substance briefly states that the Planning Director should be employed before they made a firm proposal for consultant services to The Brunswick - Glynn County Joint Planning Commission and that the Commission might consider filing request for Federal assistance through the appropriate State agency.

After discussion concerning the use of Federal assistance in connection with the contemplated advanced planning program of the Commission, motion by Mr. Parker, seconded by Mr. Paulk, that the City Manager and County Administrator be instructed to go to Atlanta for the purpose of contacting the appropriate State and Federal agencies dealing with Federal funds for advanced planning and to make such other inquiries and contacts as may be of interest and benefit to the Commission's program of planning and surveys.

Unanimously adopted.
