The Commission met with Mr. Robert H. Doyle and heard from him with respect to his qualifications for Planning Director and interest in the contemplated comprehensive zoning plan for Brunswick and Glynn County.

After discussion with Mr. Doyle, motion was made by Mr. Dubs, seconded by Mr. Parker, that the position of Planning Director for Brunswick and Glynn County be offered to Mr. Robert H. Doyle at a salary of \$7,200.00 per year plus the actual moving expenses incurred by Mr. Doyle in accomplishing his removal from the Atlanta area to Glynn County.

Unanimously adopted.

Mr. Doyle advised that the Commission would be promptly informed of his acceptance or rejection of the offer of employment as Planning Director for Brunswick and Glynn County.
