

REGULAR MEETING
NOVEMBER 15th, 1960

Following a motion by Mr. Compton which was seconded by Mr. Dubs, minutes for the meeting held October 11th, 1960, were unanimously approved as read.

A payment of \$500.00 to Hill & Adley Associates for completion of the Industrial Locations Study was authorized upon a motion by Mr. Compton. This motion was seconded by Mr. Dubs and passed unanimously.

As the next order of business, a report concerning Brunswick and Glynn County's economy was reviewed and discussed in some detail. The report as prepared by Hill & Adley was considered to need revision with regard to those portions on pages 25 and 26 dealing with agriculture and forestry products. In particular, the Commission felt that information contained in this section of the report contained some misleading data and conclusions. It was suggested that Mr. Sidney Cooper of the Brunswick Pulp & Paper Company be contacted to obtain more useful forestry products information.

Following this discussion, a motion was made by Mr. Compton, seconded by Mr. Parker, and unanimously passed to authorize a 50% payment of \$750.00 to Hill & Adley Associates for partial completion of the Economy Report.

The Commission next agreed that a 9:00 A. M. joint meeting with City and County Commissions to discuss the proposed major thoroughfare plan should be held sometime during the first ten days to two weeks of December. (*preliminary plan*)

Commission members also unanimously passed a motion made by Mr. Compton and seconded by Mr. Parker to make completed planning reports available to City and County Commission members should they desire personal copies.

In conclusion, the Commission decided to make published planning reports available to interested individuals and other communities for a price of \$1.50 per copy.
