

CALLED MEETING

THE BRUNSWICK - GLYNN COUNTY JOINT PLANNING COMMISSION

JUNE 25th, 1969

The Chairman stated that the purpose of this called meeting was two-fold:

- 1) to review possible changes to the proposed Glynn County Subdivision Regulations; and
 - 2) to discuss possible changes to the text of the City of Brunswick and Glynn County Zoning Ordinances.
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The Acting Director explained to the Commission that due to great controversy raised by subdividers, realtors, land planners and other interested parties, the proposed Glynn County Subdivision Regulations had been referred back to the Planning Commission for further study.

He further stated that he had discussed these issues at length with many of the objectors and, after careful consideration, had prepared several changes that in his opinion should be considered by the Planning Commission.

The Acting Director thereby distributed copies of the proposed changes which were discussed individually in great detail and, with the exception of a few minor revisions, were basically accepted by the members.

Thereupon, the Acting Director was instructed to prepare, for consideration of the Glynn County Commission, an analysis of the applicable changes.

Due to the lateness of the hour, discussion of the proposed changes to the text of the City and County Zoning Ordinances was tabled until the next regularly scheduled meeting.
