Mr. W. H. Cowman, recently appointed to the Planning Commission and who had been unable to attend the last regular meeting, was introduced and welcomed as a member.

Glynn County Subdivision Regulations.

The Chairman explained that the purpose of this called meeting was to hold a Public Hearing on the proposed Glynn County Subdivision Regulations.

The Director stated that copies of the draft of this instrument had been furnished to representatives of various interested groups, organizations and individuals and that he had held informal discussions with them.

Among those present for a review of the text were representatives from the Brunswick - Glynn County Board of Realtors, the Brunswick Bar Association, the Glynn County Board of Health, the County Engineering Department, the City Engineering Department, Surveyors and Engineers.

The Chairman suggested that each item of the proposed regulations be discussed in contunuity, with all present being given an opportunity to propose any modifications they deemed appropriate.

During review, a number of changes and additions were discussed at length. These items are to be considered for inclusion in a re-drafting of the text for further review at a later date. It was agreed that the Director would work with the various representatives in an attempt to alleviate problems presented during review of that portion of the regulations discussed this date.

Due to the lateness of the hour, another Public Hearing for review of the remainder of this instrument was scheduled for Tuesday, April 16th, 1974, at 8:30 A. M.
