Glynn County Subdivision Regulations.

The Chairman announced that this called meeting had been re-scheduled from April 25th, 1974, as originally slated.

The Chairman explained that the purpose of the meeting was for finalizing review of the proposed Glynn County Subdivision Regulations.

The Brunswick - Glynn County Board of Realtors, the Brunswick Bar Association, the Glynn County Board of Health, the City Engineering Department, Surveyors and Engineers were again represented. Also present were a number of interested individuals.

This review began at Article VIII with the remainder of the regulations being discussed at length in continuity, with all present being given an opportunity to propose any modifications they deemed appropriate.

As at previous meetings, a number of changes and additions suggested were discussed. The Director will acquire the proposed technical changes from the engineers and present them to the Planning Commission for their information.

Modifications suggested at all meetings held in this respect have been considered for inclusion in or exclusion from the regulations, and a re-drafting of this instrument will be prepared within the next three weeks.

The Chairman requested that any objections to the proposed regulations as modified to date be submitted to the Planning Commission in writing within 10 days.

Although no official action was taken at this meeting, it was understood that a revised edition of the regulations will be presented at a Joint Planning Commission Public Hearing for final review and recommendation to the Glynn County Commission.
