Proposed Amendments to the Text of the Glynn County Zoning Ordinance to Establish Rules and Procedures regarding Residential Densities and Lot Coverage Ratios.

The Chairman announced that this special meeting had been called for the purpose of holding a Public Hearing for review of the subject proposed amendments. Mr. Floyd added that no formal action would be taken at this time.

It was determined that these amendments would be studied in detail and in sequence, with all interested parties present being requested to express their opinions and make any suggestions they deem appropriate.

Thereupon, each item taken up was reviewed in full. As a result a number of modifications were decided upon.

Inasmuch as time did allow for all items to be discussed, it was agreed that this review be continued at another special meeting to be held on Monday, February 3rd, 1975, at 6:30 P. M.

The Director stated that, upon completion of review, all modifications will be incorporated into the proposed amendments. Following this, a finalized draft will be prepared for consideration at another duly advertised Public Hearing.

The Director pointed out that any amendments to the Glynn County Zoning Ordinance would be applicable not only to St. Simons Island but to the entire County.
