Chairman Richard Altman called the meeting to order and gave a brief recap of the rules and audience participation. He explained that there would be no action taken by the Planning Commission in that this is a hearing to gain public input on the prospect of a second Planning Commission for District 2. (This is the second of two public hearings. The first public hearing was held on March 28th at 7:00 p.m. in the Office Park Building.)

The floor was then open for discussion.

The following citizens were present to speak in favor of a second Planning Commission: Mr. Mark Bedner, Ms. Jane Johnson, Mr. Jack Kurshner, Ms. Hilliard Kinzey, Mr. Rusty Jensen and County Commissioner Geraldine Robertson. It was noted that there were at least approximately 130 citizens in attendance in favor of a second Planning Commission.

Present to speak against having a second Planning Commission were Mr. Ed Hulse and Mr. Joe McDonough. Mr. Robert Ussery of Ussery/Rule Architects was present to comment on the issue. It was noted that there were at least approximately 5 citizens in attendance not in favor of a second Planning Commission.
