Educational Sales Tax
(Vote for One)

Shall a one percent sales and use tax for educational purposes be imposed in the Glynn County School District for a period of time not to exceed 14 consecutive calendar quarters in order to raise not more than \$100,425,000 for the purpose of (a) retiring previously incurred general obligation debt of the school district in a maximum amount of \$9,508,420; and (b) funding the following capital outlay projects at a maximum total cost of \$90,916,580: (i) acquiring, constructing, and equipping a new Sterling Middle, Glynn Middle, and Southwest Middle Schools, and Charter Vocational Technical School, (ii) constructing and equipping a new 9th Grade Center, athletic facilities and site improvements at Brunswick High School, (iii) adding to, remodeling, renovating, improving, and equipping Risley Middle School, Glynn Academy 9th Grade Center, and the original Glynn Academy Building, (iv) paving and water/sewer improvements to Glynn County Stadium, (v) renovation and construction of a transportation facility including necessary demolition of the Perry Building, and (vi) acquisition of real and personal property for the school system, including any necessary demolition, site improvements and renovations, technology upgrades, computers and related technology, copiers, school buses, energy management systems, heating and air conditioning systems, lighting, and similar equipment?

If imposition of the tax is approved by the voters, such vote also shall constitute approval of the issuance of general obligation debt of the Glynn County School District in a principal amount not to exceed \$67,685,000 for the above capital outlay purposes and for the payment of capitalized interest on such debt.
