Glynn County Expands Free Wi-Fi Service in Parks

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga.- Glynn County parks have been going hi-tech for the last few years, making Wi-Fi service available to the public. The most recent park to gain Wi-Fi availability is Selden Park located on Highway 341 in Brunswick. A popular park for year-round recreational activity, Wi-Fi service has been installed and is currently isolated to the Selden Park gymnasium and its public meeting room.

“Our goal is to continue to expand these services throughout the County, as funding allows”, said John Catron, Information Technology Director. “We are very pleased to be offering this added benefit to users at Selden Park.”

Selden Park joins the ranks of a growing list of Glynn County Parks and meeting facilities to offer free Wi-Fi to its users. There are now a total of eight general sites with Wi-Fi capability, including North Glynn Recreation Complex, Neptune Park and the Casino building on St. Simons Island and both public libraries.

Extended fiber optic cable to Selden Park cost Glynn County approximately one thousand dollars. Connecting fiber optic equipment and a wireless access point to the County’s growing private fiber network has made it possible to provide wireless service at a number of public meeting spaces and parks.

(Please note: Access to Wi-Fi at Selden Park is granted by a security code which is available from County staff on site.)
