## Curbside Garbage Collection Carts

Glynn County home owners will be furnished with a 95 gallon rollout cart to use for curbside collection of household garbage.

The cart should be positioned at the curb in front of the residence no later than 7:00 am on the day of pick-up. The cart must be within five (5) feet of the road and at least three (3) feet from any obstacles (mailbox, fence, landscaping, cars, other bins, etc.) The cart should not be placed under any low hanging overhead obstacles like limbs or power lines. Carts are emptied by an automated side loader that is operated by the driver. Drivers will not exit the truck to adjust the cart if it is improperly placed. All trash in the container must be drained of all liquids and bagged in paper or plastic bags. Garbage will not be collected if it is not inside the rollout cart with the lid closed or in a special pre-paid "overflow" 30-gallon bag. Bags may be purchased from Publix or Harris Teeter.

#### 550 Young Lane:

Take everything, but the yard debris limbs must be no more than 3 inches around and only 4ft long.

Price \$35 per load

#### St. Simons Island: (Behind Demere Road Farmers Market)

Take everything, but the yard debris limbs must be no more than 3 inches around and only 4ft long.  
Hours of Operation M-F 10-3 Saturday 9-12 (Noon) Price \$35 per load

#### 5020 Habersham St.: Takes everything except yard Debris

Hours of Operation M-F 7-4:30  
Price: \$35 up to 1 ton and then goes up after that by how much the truck weights

### Cost

**\$36 per average truck load Cash, Money Orders, and Personal Checks Accepted**  
**\*\*Effective 1/1/2020, Republic Services will charge a prorated fee for cardboard drop-offs.\*\***

### These items will be accepted at the drop off centers:

- Yard Debris
- White Goods
- Bulky Items
- Metal
- Construction Debris
- Glass Bottles and Jars (must be clean & dry)

### These items will not be accepted at the drop off centers:

- Paint
- Tires
- Hazardous Materials
- Car Batteries
- Dead Animals
- Curbside Recycling

### Observed Republic Services Holidays

If your normal collection day falls on or after a holiday, your garbage collection will be one day later for the duration of that week. This includes yard debris and recycling services.

-Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day & New Year's Day

## Bulk Items, White Goods, and Extra Services

The Glynn County Public Works Department will provide 2 free pick-ups per calendar year of bulk items (furniture, moving boxes, etc.) and white goods (household appliances.)

Please contact Customer Service for your free Bulk Items and White Goods Pickup at (912) 554 - 7111.

Republic Services can also provide you with the following services:

- Extra Garbage Cart:\$107.16/year
- Extra Recycling Cart:61.56/year
- Extra pick up: \$25
- Yard Debris Service: \$122.40/year
- Back Door Service (for garbage only):\$275.40/year Charges above are prorated

- Recycling for \$81.00\* annually
- \*\$50 Fee New Customers or return a cart to a previous customer

(No need to remove: paper clips, stamps, address labels, staples, etc)

White/Pastel Office Paper  
File Folders  
Opened Mail & Greeting Cards  
Paperback books  
Phone Books  
Magazines, brochures, & Catalogs  
Paper egg cartons  
Paper Bags  
Paperboard boxes  
Newspapers & Inserts (no bags)



## 2) DO Recycle Cardboard

Bottles

## 4) DO Recycle Metal

Metal Cans  
Soda Cans  
Clean, balled aluminum foil (2" or larger)  
Pie pans



# Recycling DON'Ts



The Recycling Bin's Dirty Dozen

### 1) DON'T Recycle Plastic Bags or Plastic Film

We do not accept film plastic, shrink wrap, or bubble wrap.

### 2) DON'T Recycle Materials in Plastic Bags

Place recyclables directly in your cart in save time. The only exception is for shredded paper.

### 3) DON'T Recycle Rope-Like Items

Do not include water hoses, belts, holiday lights, etc as they can wrap around machines.

### 4) DON'T Recycle Loose Shredded Paper

Secure shredded paper in a bag, otherwise the pieces may blow out of trucks.

### 5) DON'T Recycle Styrofoam or Product Packaging

Plastic lids, Styrofoam, packing peanuts, cups and coolers are currently not recyclable.

### 6) DON'T Recycle Liquids

Please completely empty and quickly rinse out all containers before recycling.

### 7) DON'T Recycle Glass or Ceramics

We do not accept glass, ceramic, china, dishes, mirrors, light bulbs, or window glass.

### 8) DON'T Recycle Diapers or Bio-Hazardous Waste

Syringes and needles, diapers and other sanitary products are not recyclable.

### 9) DON'T Recycle Hazardous Waste or Electronics

Paint, automotive fluids, batteries, and pesticides must be disposed of in a specialized way

### 10) DON'T Recycle Scrap Metal or Automotive Parts

Scrap metal of any size, including metal hangers, should not go in your curbside cart

### 11) DON'T Recycle Frozen Food Boxes or Waxed Cardboard

Frozen pizza and entrées, juice boxes and milk cartons are not recyclable because they have a plastic polymer sprayed on them to protect against freezer burn.

### 12) DON'T Recycle Food Contaminated Items

Cardboard or plastic like pizza boxes that contain irremovable food waste, such as grease, should not be placed in the recycling cart.
