**OFFICIAL ABSENTEE/PROVISIONAL/CHALLENGED BALLOT**

**OFFICIAL GENERAL MUNICIPAL AND SPECIAL ELECTION BALLOT OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA  
NOVEMBER 3, 2015**

To vote, blacken the Oval (●) next to the candidate of your choice. To vote for a person whose name is not on the ballot, manually WRITE his or her name in the write-in section and blacken the Oval (●) next to the write-in section. If you desire to vote YES or NO for a PROPOSED QUESTION, blacken the corresponding Oval (●). Use only blue or black pen or pencil.

Do not vote for more candidates than the number allowed for each specific office. Do not cross out or erase. If you erase or make other marks on the ballot or tear the ballot, your vote may not count.

If you change your mind or make a mistake, you may return the ballot by writing "Spoiled" across the face of the ballot and return envelope. You may then mail the spoiled ballot back to your county board of registrars, and you will be issued another official absentee ballot. Alternatively, you may surrender the ballot to the poll manager of an early voting site within your county or the precinct to which you are assigned. You will then be permitted to vote a regular ballot.

**SPECIAL ELECTION**

**1 % Sales Tax for Educational Purposes**  
(Vote for One)

Shall a one percent sales and use tax for educational purposes be imposed in the Glynn County School District for a period of time not to exceed 20 consecutive calendar quarters in order to raise not more than \$130,000,000 for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, and equipping the following capital outlay projects: (a) a new Burroughs-Molette Elementary School; (b) a new Altama Elementary School; (c) renovations and improvements to Glynn Academy including Athletic Facilities; (d) renovations and improvements to the Brunswick High School Athletic Facilities; (e) renovations and improvements to the Glynn County Stadium; (f) renovations and improvements to the Needwood Middle Baseball Field & Weight Room; (g) a new Coastal Community Center for the Arts; (h) a new elementary school #11; and (i) other real and personal property for the school system, including any necessary demolition, site improvements, renovations, and improvements to facilities, land acquisition, technology upgrades, computers and related technology including fiber and software, telephone and communication equipment, computerized energy management systems, heating and air conditioning systems, lighting, and similar property and equipment in accordance with its facilities plans, as the same may be revised in accordance with the needs of the School District?

If imposition of the tax is approved by the voters, such vote shall also constitute approval of the issuance of general obligation debt of the Glynn County School District in a principal amount not to exceed \$70,000,000 for the above capital outlay purposes and for the payment of capitalized interest on such debt.
