

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS ROADS AND REVENUE HELD WEDNESDAY, JANUARY 10, 1940.

Minutes previous meeting read and approved.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to approve all expenditures for period December 13, 1939 to January 10, 1940, inclusive in the total amount of \$97,288.05, covered by Vouchers #55251 to #55443. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Paulk to elect R. A. Gould Chairman of Commissioners Roads and Revenue of Glynn County for the year 1940. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Harley to elect H. J. Friedman Engineer-Clerk for the year 1940. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to increase the salary of H. J. Friedman, Engineer-Clerk, to \$425.00 per month and to increase his allowance for his car operation to \$75.00 per month. Unanimously adopted.

A delegation headed by Mr. Vinson Spinelli, New England Tourist Camp, consisting of Tourist Camp Operators, Filling Station Operators, Pecan Stations and other interested parties appeared before the Commission in the interest of lightening the restrictions controlling advertising signs along the Coastal Highway. After careful consideration, it was moved by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to notify the delegation to submit their recommendations in writing at the earliest possible time for further consideration by the County Commissioners. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Harley, Seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to allot the Salvation Army and Y. W. C. A. \$20.00 each month during the year 1940, with the understanding that they are to submit a monthly report and that the allotment to the Salvation Army is to be used for actual relief of the needy. Commissioners Royal, Owens, Harley, Abbott and Paulk voting Aye, Commissioner Ratcliffe voting Nay.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Paulk, to allot \$1750.00 to the Timber Protective Organization for the year 1940 to be paid in monthly installments. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Owens, to increase the salary of Mrs. Maude Lambright, Director of Glynn County Department of Public Welfare from \$125.00 to \$135.00 per month. Commissioners Owens, Royal, Abbott and Paulk voting Aye, Commissioners Ratcliffe and Harley voting Nay.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Paulk, to include in the Budget an allotment of \$10.00 per month for each Glynn County Timber Protective Organization Ranger for the period 1940 for services as Deputy Game Wardens. Commissioners Ratcliffe, Paulk, Abbott voting Aye, Commissioners Owens and Harley voting Nay. Commissioner Royal not voting.

Motion by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to accept the 1940 Budget involving total estimated receipts of \$300,915.00 and estimated expenditures in the same amount, subject to the above revisions was adopted by unanimous vote.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Harley, and unanimously adopted as follows:

"BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, That the Brunswick Bank and Trust Company be and is hereby appointed and designated as the official depository for all County Funds for Glynn County for a period of twelve months beginning January 1st, 1940, or to such time as this Board should see fit to change same; said designated depository having qualified under the Act of the 1933 Legislature of the State of Georgia by giving ample security which has been approved and accepted by the Commissioners of Roads and Revenue and which is listed as follows:-

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to invest Seventy Five Hundred (\$7500.00) Dollars of Glynn County's reserve funds in United States Savings Bonds having a maturity value ten years from date of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Harley, Seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to direct the Clerk to request the Tax Assessors to meet with the County Commissioners at the regular February meeting to discuss the 1940 Digest. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Harley, to establish the following policy on applications for construction of pole lines on the Right of Way of Glynn County's Roads and other County property. Unanimously adopted.

- 1- The applicant to submit a formal application supported by a detailed sketch.
- 2- Permission to be based on a formal agreement prepared and approved by the County Attorney and approved by the County Engineer.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Royal to defer action on the request of the St. Simons Island Board of Trade for releasing the Board of Trade and endorsers from their obligation in connection with the \$1500.00 note given the County supporting the advance in that amount by the County for providing certain recreational facilities on the Glynn County Casino Grounds. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Harley, Seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to authorize the Chairman and the Clerk to adjust the taxes in the cases of Mr. Ned C. Willoughby and Camp Reese. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Owens, Seconded by Commissioner Harley, to allot not to exceed \$100.00 in connection with the Historical Survey Project for Glynn County. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Owens, Seconded by Commissioner Royal, to remit, as provided by law, the property taxes in connection with the proposed plant of John D. Lewis, Inc. at the site near the Georgia Veneer & Package Company for a period not to exceed five years. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Owens, Seconded by Commissioner Royal, to approve invitation and necessary expenses for the 8th District County Association's meeting to be held in Brunswick, February 8th. Unanimously adopted.
