

## REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS ROADS &amp; REVENUE, HELD TUESDAY, JUNE 4TH., 1940.

PRESENT:- J. L. Owens, C. V. Abbott, R. L. Ratcliffe and J. B. D. Paulk.

In the absence of Mr. Gould, Chairman, it was moved by Commissioner Owens, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe to appoint Commissioner Abbott, Acting Chairman. Unanimously adopted.

Minutes previous meeting read and approved.

Moved by Commissioner Ratcliffe, Seconded by Commissioner Paulk to approve all disbursements for the period May 7th., to June 4th., 1940, Inclusive, in the total amount of \$25,013.38, covered by Voucher #56063 - 56227 Incl. Unanimously adopted.

Mr. T. Q. Fleming appeared before the Board and presented a letter with reference to the land lines between his property and Estate of J. H. Holtzendorf in the 1356th. District.

After discussion Mr. Fleming was informed that the Commissioners had no authority in the matter and Mr. Fleming's letter was ordered filed.

Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Owens, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe to authorize the State Highway Board of Georgia to draw all future Checks for Glynn County in favor of "Commissioners of Roads and Revenue, Glynn County" instead of to "Treasurer of Glynn County, Georgia." Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Ratcliffe, Seconded by Commissioner Paulk to approve list of "Errors and Defaulters Relieved" presented by J. M. Exley, Tax Commissioner under date of May 31st., 1940, covering 3 Sheets, totaling \$292.43. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Owens, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe to authorize payment to Tax Commissioner, Exley on 10% of Tax Collections in excess of 90% in accordance with the law based on the Auditor's Reports for each 6 months period beginning July 1st., 1940. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Ratcliffe, Seconded by Commissioner Paulk to make refund to the Wright Estate property in the 1356th. District on over-payment of 1938-1939 County taxes due to increase in the acreage returned. The Wright Estate returned 2210 acres in 1938 and 1939 whereas a later survey showing a total 1390.8 acres. Refund based on a \$3.00 valuation and the 17 Mills County Levy is \$41.75 for 1938 and \$38.75 for 1939. an acre/Unanimously adopted.

Mrs. George Gowen appeared before the County Commission on behalf of the St. Simons Board of Trade, requesting traffic regulation of the St. Simons Beaches.

On motion of Commissioner Owens, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe the following resolution was unanimously adopted:-

1. "That necessary signs be erected and traffic controlled on St. Simons Beach from the County Pier East to a point near the King and Prince Club by restricting vehicles to automobiles, (no Scooters, or Sail Boats to be allowed in this area) and that the maximum speed of automobiles on the beach be held to 20 miles per hour.
2. That no automobiles be permitted on the beach area West of the pier but that Scooters and Sail Boats be permitted to operate in this area.
3. That all Scooters whether on the Beach or public roads be governed to a maximum speed of 20 miles per hour."

Moved by Commissioner Owens, Seconded by Commissioner Paulk to request the City Commission to take prompt action on the report of Dr. D. Henry Poer on the City Hospital, Brunswick, and suggest that a joint meeting of the City and County authorities be held before a final decision on the different phases of the operation of the Hospital is reached. Unanimously adopted.
