

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS ROADS & REVENUE HELD TUESDAY, August 6, 1940.

Minutes previous meeting read and approved.

The following reports were approved and ordered filed:-

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Harley, to approve all disbursements for the period July 3rd to August 5th, 1940 in the total amount of \$24,503.50, covered by Vouchers #56425-56629. Unanimously adopted.

T. Q. Fleming appeared before the Commission and requested credit on his Tax Deed on his property near Pyles Marsh for working the Community Road leading to his property. Moved by Commissioner Harley, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to refer the request to the Engineer-Director for investigation and recommendation. Unanimously adopted.

Mrs. Wilda Tostensen appeared before the Commission with reference to improvement of the ditch along the old Jesup Highway adjacent to her property. Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Harley, to refer the matter to the Engineer-Director and the Road Superintendent for investigation and recommendation. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Harley, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to approve the extension of the contract of the Manly Construction Company for surfacing Project 1583-C to cover Sand Bituminous Road Mix surfacing of the approaches to Sea Island and East Beach bridges @ 20¢ per Sq. Yd. for 5" compacted Sand Bituminous Road Mix and \$.0099 per gallon for application of Bituminous Material. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to authorize installation of flag pole on Court House grounds and to request the American Legion to sponsor appropriate ceremonies for the dedication. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to approve tentative plans and financial arrangements for application for construction of an Armory as a W. P. A. Project on the basis of the City and County participating 50% each in sponsors costs, subject to approval of final arrangements and contracts. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to refer to the County Attorney the verbal request of the Sea Island Company for a resolution in connection with the Beach Control on St. Simons Island to the effect that the said control does not jeopardize any rights that the Sea Island Company may have to the Beach from the County Pier at the extension of Mallory Street, West. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Ratcliffe, seconded by Commissioner Paulk, to pay Mr. G. W. Popwell for a period of two months in the event he resigns on account of physical disability. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Harley, to authorize the Young Mens' Club to divert the balance of fund originally contributed by the County for advertising signs to construction of shelters on the Glynn County Golf Course. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Owens, seconded by Commissioner Harley, to make the following increases in compensation:-

Increase Clair Jones from \$135.00 to \$150.00 per month.
Increase J. E. Bush from \$175.00 to \$190.00 per month.
Increase Mrs. Jeanne Gordon from \$100.00 to \$110.00 per month.
Increase Miss Ollie Mae Tomberlin from \$125.00 to \$130.00 per month.

Increase Mrs. I. L. Jessup from \$120.00 to \$125.00 per month.
 Increase Mrs. Helen Malone from \$70.00 to \$80.00 per month.
 Increase Mrs. Dorothy Thiott from \$100.00 to \$125.00 per month. (Including car allowance.)
 Increase Wesley Myers' car allowance from \$10.00 to \$25.00 per month.

Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Harley, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to advise Dr. Webb Conn that it is expected that he proceed with the operation of the County Clinic under the regulations furnished him December 12, 1939, and the recommendations of the Glynn County Medical Society. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Harley, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to revoke the dance hall, tourist camp, barbecue and public amusement license of "Whitten's Place" in accordance with the recommendation of Dr. M. E. Winchester, Commissioner of Health. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to appropriate \$260.00 to the Young Mens' Club for expenses covering a campaign for increasing the registration list in Glynn County, with the suggestion that the Young Mens' Club call on the City for the remaining \$260.00 estimated necessary for said expenses. Voting Aye - Abbott, Paulk, Royal, Ratcliffe and Owens. Voting Nay - Harley.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to reject requests for adjustments of Back Taxes and Tax Deeds made by B. N. Nightingale in behalf of Mrs. Adeline Timmons and Mrs. Berrie. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Harley, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to authorize the Glynn County Department of Public Welfare to place in the Georgia Industrial Home the three sons of Lester Roddenberry at a total expense to the County of \$15.00 per month. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to advertise the equity of Glynn County in the property of J. D. and Algertha Diggs on Cochran Avenue on request of any interested purchaser. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Paulk, to permit the operation of pin ball slot machines without pay-off devices, subject to the same restrictions and licensing regulations as the City of Brunswick operates under. Voting Aye- Royal, Abbott, Paulk. Voting Nay - Harley and Ratcliffe. Not voting - Owens.


