

CALLED MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS ROADS AND REVENUE HELD WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 11, 1940.

Present:- R. A. Gould, J. B. D. Paulk, J. L. Owens, V. H. Royal, W. McD. Harley, C. V. Abbott and R. L. Ratcliffe.

The meeting was called to order by the Chairman for the purpose of investigating the shooting of Mr. Boots Harrison, at the old road between Anguilla and Thalmann by County Officers on August 12, 1940.

After testimony by Mr. Mitchell Owens, Deputy Sheriff, Chief Godwin and Officers Krauss, Gay and Connie Harrison in which it was indicated that said Boots Harrison had fired twice at the Officers before the Officers fired, the following Resolution was unanimously adopted:-

"Moved by Commissioner Abbott, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to exonerate the police officers from any blame in connection with said shooting."
