Minutes previous meeting read and approved.


This meeting called for the purpose of review and field inspection of the years' operations.

Moved by Commissioner Ratcliffe, seconded by Commissioner Paulk, to appoint Mr. J. T. Young as Processioner in the 1356th Militia District replacing Mr. R. M. Brown appointed at the meeting of December 5, 1940, who advised that he is unable to serve. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to turn over to the Golf Course the 1936 Model Chevrolet 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ Ton Truck, Tag #756 which has been used on W. P. A. operations. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to authorize the Engineer-Director to purchase a Toro Bullet Hi-Way Mower, with hand lift, sickle bar attachment complete with 60 H. P. Hercules engine at a price of \$999.00 delivered, in accordance with the quotation of the Blalock Machinery and Equipment Company, which is understood to be on the basis on which these machines are being sold to the State Highway Department for the current year. Unanimously adopted.

The meeting then adjourned and the Commissioners made an inspection in the field of the work done during the current calender year.
