

SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS ROADS & REVENUE, HELD FEBRUARY 10, 1938.

Present: R.A.Gould, J.L.Owens, R.L.Ratcliffe, W.McD.Harley, C.V.Abbott and J.B.D.Paulk.

The City Commission, headed by the Mayor and City Manager, appeared before the Commissioners urging the further assistance of the County on the filling in by Dredge of the Park at the east-end of Gloucester Street. The Mayor stated that they estimated the total cost of this work to complete eleven acres of this fill at around \$12,500.00, of which \$8,500.00 had been spent, the County having previously contributed \$3,000.00 of this amount, thus leaving a balance of \$4,000.00 to be spent. Mr. Hopkins stated they wished the County to participate in the expenditure on a fifty-fifty basis with the City which would require an additional appropriation by the County of \$3,125.00.

After the City Commission was heard from, a lengthy discussion took place which resulted in the following motion by Mr.Abbott:-


That the County appropriate an additional \$2,000.00 for the completion of this work.
