Moved by Commissioner Abbott, seconded by Commissioner Royal that survey in  
connection with Erosion on St.Simons Island Pier Section be handled by County Engineer in  
connection with the Federal Government and it is hereby authorized that the County stand  
One-half of the expense of such survey to be conducted by the Federal Authorities.

Moved by Commissioner Paulk, seconded by Commissioner Abbott that Program for  
Betterments as outlined by County Engineer Friedman be carried out as follows:-

1. Resurfacing limerock roads, clearing right of way and stream-lining slopes, reworking intersections on the twenty-two mile limerock system on Sea Island and St.Simons Island.
2. Erosion control St.Simons Beach.
3. Widening pavement, placing Curb and Gutter at the Pier Section, providing Parking Area, Walks and Driveways.
4. Paving and Sidewalk construction on Railroad Avenue, St.Simons Island, from Mallory Street to Demere Road.
5. New Bridge and re-location at Black Banks River, Sea Island.

6. Paving Arnold Road from Ocean Boulevard to Downing Street, Downing Street to Railroad Avenue, Railroad Avenue to 5th. Street and 5th. Street to Ocean Boulevard.
7. Paving and Sidewalk construction Sea Island Drive, Sea Island.
8. New Bridge and re-location at Bloody Marsh Crossing, East Beach.
9. Paving Annie Street and Wood Avenue to Bruce Drive. Paving Bruce Drive from 9th., to 11th., Streets.
10. Paving Coupers Point Road from Frederica River to Taylor's Camp.
11. Paving road through Glynn Haven Estates to Dunbar River.
12. Reconstructing Trailer Camp.
13. Paving from intersection at Butler Avenue from Mallory Street to the Golf Course.

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that The National Bank of Brunswick and The Brunswick Bank & Trust Company be and they are hereby appointed and designated as the Official Depositories for all County Funds for Glynn County for a period of twelve months from Jan. 1st., 1939 or to such time as this Board may see fit to change the same.
