Mr. Paulk and Mr. Abbott who are Directors in the County T. P. O. brought up for discussion the matter of support by the County of the organization for the twelve (12) months period beginning July 1st., 1939. It was stated by them that the State Organization has been operating the local organization for the past six (6) months and have prepared a Budget for the 12 months period beginning July 1st., amounting to \$8,710.00 of which the Federal Government, through the State, will furnish 40%, leaving a balance of \$5,226.00 to be provided by the local organization.

After discussion, Mr. Paulk and Mr. Abbott were instructed to accept for the local organization this proposed Budget and to secure certain figures regarding taxable values on timberland property with the view to further consider of ways and means for the County Commission to raise the amount. Action being deferred until future meeting.
