

REGULAR MONTHLY MEEING OF COMMISSIONERS ROADS & REVENUE TO BE HELD MAY 2, 1939 WAS RECESSED OVER UNTIL MAY 4TH., 1939, AT THE DIRECTION OF THE CHAIRMAN.

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Present: R.A.Gould, W.McD.Harley, C.V.Abbott, V.H.Royal, J.B.D.Paulk, and R.L.Ratcliffe.

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Minutes previous meeting read and approved.

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Edo Miller appeared before Board asking that tables on Casino grounds be erected for use of serving shore dinner for State Garden Club Convention in May.

On motion this matter was referred to Commissioner Harley for action.

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It was ordered that a person be employed to collect delinquent taxes in the office of J.M.Exley, Tax Commissioner at a salary of of \$200.00 per month. On motion by Commissioner Royal, vote was unanimous that R.A.Gould at which time the following resolution was offered and adopted:-

IT BEING MADE TO APPEAR to this Board that Delinquent Tax Executions for the years 1932-1933-1934-1935 & 1936 will be turned over to the Tax Commissioner for collection within the next few days, AND,

IT FURTHER APPEARING that the Tax Commissioner and the present help he has in his office have not the time to collect these Insolvent Fi.Fas.

THEREFORE, BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that R.A.Gould, Esq., be employed at a salary of \$200.00 per Month, to assist with the collections of these Fi Fas.

The vote was unanimous.

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On Motion by Commissioner Abbott, seconded by Royal, it was ordered that salary of H.J.Friedman be increased \$25.00 per month effective May 1st.

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Mrs.C.H.Leavy, Mrs.S.K.Brown and Mrs.J.B.Avera appeared before Commission asking for permission to erect a Club room as Civin Center to be attached on to Visitor's Club, On motion, that matter was referred to County Engineer Friedman for handling and report at next meeting.

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On motion by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Abbott, authority was given County Engineer Friedman and Commissioner Harley to proceed with paving on Mallory Street, St. Simons Island if it was advisable to do so.

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The following resolution offered by Commissioner Paulk was ordered spread on minutes:-

WHEREAS, Miss Ophelia Dent is executing and delivering to the State Highway Board of Georgia a portion of land for right-of-way which lies within the right-of-way line as shown on the plan for Federal (State) Aid Project No.195, which plans are on file in the Office of the State Highway Board of Georgia, Atlanta, Georgia, right-of-way beginning at station 70 / 89.8 which is the boundary line between the line of beginning of project and land of Miss Ophelia Dent, and continuing to station 76 / 50 best shown by sketch attached to said right-of-way deed, containing approximately 560.2 lineal feet or 0.8176 acres;

AND WHEREAS the State Highway Board of Georgia has agreed in consideration of said right-of-way grant by said Miss Ophelia Dent to construct a ditch on the inside of the North right-of-way line and parallel to the right-of-way line from approximately station 70, which is the beginning of the project, to intersection of the old canal at approximately station 85, to afford an outlet from the present canal parallel with the old canal to the river through the old canal near station 85.

NOW THEREFORE, be it and it is hereby resolved that the Commissioners of Roads and Revenues of Glynn County, Georgia, in consideration of the grant of said right-of-way to said Highway Board, which is for the public welfare and best interest of the County of Glynn, does hereby agree, covenant and warrant that the said ditch shall be constructed as above stated by the State Highway Board of Georgia, and that the Commissioners of Roads and Revenues of Glynn County, Georgia, will see that the same is done; and if it is not done that such a drainage ditch will be constructed by said County of Glynn.

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Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Commissioner Abbott that County Attorney be instructed to collect \$1,000.00 from Mrs.W.L.Harwell as per conversations with her, also that proceedings was not to be instituted against either of the Banks nor Brunswick Peninsula Company.

Moved by Commissioner Harley, seconded by Ratcliffe that County Attorney be instructed to proceed against property of W.L.Harwell that can be located and appears to be owned by Harwell

Committee appeared from St.Simons Board of Trade with Petition asking that County Commissioners appoint advisory Committee from membership of Board of Trade, St.Simons to work in conjunction with the County Commission for handling matters that might come up regarding St.Simons Island.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, seconded by Abbott that the request be granted and that St.Simons Board of Trade appoint three (3) members to act in an Advisory capacity for the supervision of St.Simons and that Commissioner Harley and County Engineer Friedman to be members of this Committee making a total of five (5) members.

Request was received from Y.W.C.A. asking for exemption of taxes on their building; moved by Royal, seconded by Ratcliffe that tax exemption be granted.

Mr.J.Robert Bruce and Ray Whittee as Committee from St. Simons Board of Trade appeared asking for a loan from the County of \$1,500.00 to be used in erecting Playground Equipment on St.Simons Island, also requesting that the use of Casino grounds be granted for the use of a Playground and erection of other amusement devices.

On motion by Commissioner Harley, seconded by Commissioner Royal that a Loan for \$1,500.00 be granted the St.Simons Board of Trade and that said loan should be secured by at least 20 or 25 personal Endorsers.

Also, location and type of Equipment to be approved by Chairman and County Engineer.


