In the matter of collection of Delinquent Taxes, it being made to appear that there is a number of fi fas on hand with no chance for collection, a resolution was offered by Commissioner Harley, Seconded by Commissioner Royal that Mr. Gould be instructed to prepare a list of such fi fas from time to time that in his opinion should be charged off, and present same for Commissioners's approval for such charge-off.

A Resolution offered by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Paulk, that Miss Ollie Mae Tomberlin be elected Deputy Clerk, with authority to sign Vouchers and other necessary papers. Carried.

Resolution offered by Commissioner Abbott, seconded by Commissioner Paulk that Chief of County Police be instructed to notify all operators of Slot Machines that such all Slot Machines shall be placed in back rooms and that, effective Sept.1st., 1939 the operation of such machines shall be discontinued completely, this to apply to entire County.

Resolution was offered by Commissioner Harley, Seconded by Commissioner Royal that the sum of \$875.00 be appropriated to the Timber Protective Organization for Forest Protection, this to be paid in 6 Monthly payment.
