

REGULAR MONTHLY MEETING OF COMMISSIONERS ROADS & REVENUE HELD TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 7th, 1939.

Minutes previous meeting read and approved.

Moved by Commissioner Harley, Seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to approve all monthly bills for October 1939. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Owens, to request the City Hospital Authorities to make a strong effort to reduce their accounts receivable which, on the statement as at October 1st, 1939, totals \$17,378.33. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Owens, Seconded by Commissioner Royal, to authorize the Clerk to take up with Dr. Winchester and the County Medical Association the feasibility of establishing a joint City and County Clinic and securing their recommendations. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to accept the report and recommendations of the Special Tax Collector which calls for discontinuing the services of the Special Tax Collector as of December 31st, 1939, transferring all tax records to the office of the Tax Commissioner, Mrs. Malone to continue in that office assisting in the clerical work under the direction of the Tax Commissioner; and approval of the lists of October 31st, 1939 of Defaulters Relieved, as submitted. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Harley, Seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to settle the J. J. Heard 1932-1938 taxes on the basis of adjusting the valuation to bring the amount of taxes in line with the city taxes. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Owens, to refer the matter of adjustment of the Zion Baptist Association taxes to the Chairman and Clerk. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Owens, to revise, in accordance with the request of Mayor J. Hunter Hopkins, the resolution of March 17th, 1939, appropriating 50% of the cost of securing the Right of Way on Project #261 total cost to the County not to exceed \$5,000.00, by increasing the total cost to the County to not to exceed \$7500.00. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Royal, to take a half page ad in the Mail-away Edition of the Brunswick Pilot at a cost of \$50.00. Commissioners Royal, Abbott, Paulk and Ratcliffe voting aye, Commissioners Owens and Harley voting nay.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Harley, to request the Board of Tax Assessors to give Mr. Dan Middleton, acting for Cator Woolford, an opportunity to arbitrate the valuation placed on the Woolford property in connection with the 1939 tax return. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to compensate Mrs. A. O. Townsend in the amount of \$500.00 as full settlement for the personal cars of Mr. Townsend, one Buick per Voucher #32598 and one 1930 Cadillac per Voucher #43583, which cars were traded in and given credit on the purchase of County cars. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Owens, Seconded by Commissioner Royal, to increase the salary of Chief of Police Godwin from \$160.00 to \$175.00, effective December 1st, 1939. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Owens, Seconded by Commissioner Paulk, to refer to the Chairman and Clerk the tax settlement of Mr. J. E. Abbott handled in the Resolution of September 8th, 1939, by adjusting and settling the question of these taxes through 1939 in line with the understanding between Mr. Abbott and the late Mr. A. O. Townsend, Clerk. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to notify the St. Simons Board of Trade that they will be expected to make a substantial payment in an amount not less than \$750.00 by September 15th, 1940 on their \$1500.00 note to Glynn County. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Owens, Seconded by Commissioner Abbott, that the City and the Board of Education, and property owners with past due notes on Windsor Park holdings, be requested to make settlement before the end of the calendar year. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to request our legislators to secure passage, in the event of a special session of the State Legislature, of legislation which would give the County authority to license all classes of business in the County located outside of the City of Brunswick. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Abbott, Seconded by Commissioner Ratcliffe, to accept the proposal of November 1st, 1939 from M. H. Barnes & Company, Savannah, Georgia, for auditing the fiscal records of the County for the six months period ending December 31st, 1939 and six months period ending June 30th, 1940 at a total cost for both examinations not to exceed \$750.00. Unanimously adopted.

Moved by Commissioner Royal, Seconded by Commissioner Abbott, to accept the offer of Mr. C. H. Postell, St. Simons Island, Georgia, for his property on Demere Road, east of Malcolm McKinnon Airport, being approximately 2.20 acres on which his residence is located, for the sum of \$3,000.00, Mr. Postell to move off the house and garage and all personal property including all fruit trees. Unanimously adopted.
