## **Free spay/neuter program available**

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga. – The PETCO Foundation recently awarded \$25,000 to the Glynn County Animal Control Services. A portion of these funds are to support a free spay/neuter program for the community called “Friends Don’t let Friends have Litters.” The goal is to perform approximately 200 surgeries over the course of August and September.

Pet owners who would like to participate must be 18 years of age and a resident of Glynn County. Low income guidelines will apply. You must provide proof of residence and income status. Applications must be filled out person at Glynn County Animal Control (no phone calls). If you qualify, you will be given an appointment date at the time the application is submitted. This is a time restricted offer, and pets will be spayed/neutered on a first come, first served basis.
