## **Rededication of Baldwin Park at Brookman**

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga. – Glynn County Commissioner Michael Browning (District 1) rededicated Baldwin Park at Brookman during a brief community ceremony this morning. Approximately 35 people were gathered to cut a ribbon rededicating the park. In addition, Commissioner Browning presented Mr. Calvin Waye, leader of the Tri-Area Association, with the Calvin Waye Lane street sign that will be placed on the entrance road to the park.

Glynn County Public Works began making improvements to Baldwin Park in the fall of 2014. In the last year, tennis courts have been constructed, the new Calvin Waye Lane was paved with asphalt, Phase 1 of the Tree Board's landscaping plan was implemented (seven Live Oaks, three Southern Red Cedars, and three American Hollies), a new rook was installed on the community building, and the community building received a fresh coat of paint.
