Post Hermine yard debris

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga.- The Glynn County Board of Commissioners would like to remind the public of the following options for dumping yard debris following Hurricane Hermine.

Currently there are two public drop off sites operated by Republic Services, the County contractor for trash and recycling services:

- 1) 550 Young Lane, Brunswick
- 2) Demere Rd (near the farmer's market by the airport), St. Simons.

The normal hours of operation are Monday – Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. and Saturday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Due to the Labor Day Holiday, Republic Services will be closed and the drop off centers will not be open on Monday, September 5, 2016. The cost is \$13 per average truck load. Items accepted include: yard debris, white items (household appliances), bulky items, metal, and construction debris. The following items will not be accepted at drop off centers: paint; tires; hazardous materials; car batteries; dead animals; or refrigerators, freezers, or air conditioners that do not have a certification by a licensed technician of CFC recovery.

The Public will be notified of any changes to the current options for the disposal of yard waste.
