Tropical Storm Hermine

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga.- With the latest information from the US National Weather Service Jacksonville Florida the local impacts for Glynn County from Hurricane Hermine, now downgraded to Tropical Storm Hermine, are going to continue into the morning hours of Friday September 2, 2016. We are still expecting to see winds of 40-50 mph with the possibility of gusts of 60mph or higher. There will continue to be wind, rain, and power outages as the storm event tracks into the Atlantic.

Multiple traffic signals are out due to power outages. If there is not an officer present directing traffic, the intersection should be treated as a four-way stop.
