RS&H to host open house on proposed county ordinance changes

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga.-The consulting firm of RS&H will host a drop-in “Open House” style forum to seek public input on the proposed ordinance changes that have been recommended as a result of the development moratorium on St. Simons. RS&H has been retained by the County to assist with the process of developing new ordinances to address development issues.
