

**Georgia Department of Transportation
To Hold
A Location and Design Public Hearing Open House
For P.I. No. 532650
Glynn County
Project Number STP00-00009-(092)**

On Thursday, March 09, 2017 at the Brunswick Christian Academy - Gym, located at 4132 US Highway 17 North, Brunswick, Georgia 31525, the Georgia Department of Transportation will hold a Public Hearing Open House concerning the project listed above.

The proposed project includes widening and reconstructing State Route (SR) 25/United States (US) Route 17 (Ocean Highway) from the intersection of Yacht Drive, north to the intersection of SR 99/Grant's Ferry Road. The existing two-lane section would be widened to include four 12-foot travel lanes with a 12-foot raised median and 8-foot rural outside shoulders (6 foot 6 inches paved). Auxiliary turn lanes would be provided at major intersections and at proposed median openings. The existing bridges along SR 25/US 17 over Thornhill Creek and Wallyleg Branch would be replaced with new 4-lane structures. The existing right-of-way (ROW) varies from 75-200 feet. The proposed ROW is expected to be between 200-250 feet. The total length of the proposed project is approximately 6.4 miles.

The purpose of this Location and Public Hearing Open House (PHOH) is to provide the public with an opportunity to view the project, ask questions, and comment on the project. Relocation assistance will be discussed at the Open House.

The Open House will be held from 5:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. It will be informal, and the public is invited to attend anytime during these hours. There will be no formal presentation. A court reporter will be available to allow the public an opportunity to make verbal comments about the project.

Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) Information:

The displays at the Public Hearing Open House will be available for ten days for review after the Open House at the GDOT Brunswick Area Office. In addition, comments and statements resulting from the Open House will be available from the GDOT Atlanta office approximately 30 days after the PHOH.
