## **JWSC project to cause upcoming road closures**

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga.- The Brunswick-Glynn County Joint Water Sewer Commission (BGJWSC) will begin work on the project referred to as PS4048 in the Arco area of Brunswick. This project will replace 3,100 linear feet of existing force main piping with 24-inch piping for wastewater discharge. The area affected by construction will be Fifth Street, from Norwich St. to Lee St.; Lee St. from Fifth St. through Paula Park; and Branham Ave. from Paula Park to Townsend St. In addition, Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. will be blocked at Fifth Street for a short period of time during construction.

The project will begin in August 2017 and is expected to be complete by December 2017. Traffic controls will be present, where necessary, throughout the project.

PSAs will be issued throughout the project to alert the public of upcoming road closures for specific areas of construction. In addition, the BGJWSC will be hosting an informational meeting in the Brunswick High Auditorium on Thursday, August 3, 2017 from 5:30-7:00PM. During this time, members of BGJWSC staff, elected officials and staff from the construction team at TB Landmark Construction will be present to answer questions related to this project.
