Glynn County names Planning Manager

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga. – Stefanie Leif has been selected as the new Planning Manager for Glynn County, Georgia. As Planning Manager, Ms. Leif will be responsible for managing the operations and activities of the Planning Division to include overseeing the review of site plans and land development applications for compliance with County codes and ordinances. In addition, Ms. Leif will serve as the chief staff liaison with the Planning Commissions and other official boards and committees addressing planning issues.

Ms. Leif has 16 years of land use planning experience at the city, county, and regional levels of government. Since 2015, she has been employed by the City of Lansing, Kansas as the Director of Community and Economic Development. Prior to that, she served as the Director of Community Development for Achinson, Kansas; Planning Manager for Ketchum, Idaho; County Planner II for Hailey, Idaho; and Staff Planner for the Central Vermont Regional Planning Commission.

Ms. Leif holds a Master of Public Administration from Marist College and a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Environmental Studies and Sociology from St. Lawrence University. She has been a certified planner with the American Institute of Certified Planners (AICP) since 2006.

County Manager, Alan Ours, said the following about Ms. Leif: “I am excited to welcome Stefanie Leif to the Glynn County team. After an exhaustive search for Planning Manager, I believe that we have found the right person with the right experience for the job. Ms. Leif has a wealth of experience in both planning and management which is well suited for the position.
