Nonpartisan qualifying is at the office of the Board of Elections, 1815 Gloucester Street, Brunswick.

Independent Candidates must file a Notice of Candidacy, pay the qualifying fee and are also required to file a nominating petition for placement on the General Election ballot. (O.C.G.A. § 21-2-132 and § 21-2-170) According to O.C.G.A. § 21-2-132(d)

*Due to a code change during the 2017 session, there is **ONLY** one qualifying period for independent and political body candidates.*

Independent and political body candidates qualifying the SAME time as everyone else, March 5–March 9. Contact the Board of Elections at 912-554-7060 to obtain the number of signatures required. **Nominating petitions must be filed by Noon on Tuesday, July 10.**

The General/Special/Non-Partisan Election will be held on November 6, 2018.
