Neptune Park Branch Broken

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga.- A Live Oak Tree branch has broken in the picnic table area of Neptune Park. The branch, measuring over 50 feet long, snapped at the trunk of the tree and the only solution is to remove it. Glynn County Public Works will cut the branch at the trunk of the tree on Saturday, June 21, 2018, in order to make the area safe for visitors. As of Friday, July 20, 2018, the branch is stable and not at risk of falling further, but as a precaution the area is blocked off with barricades.

Please avoid sitting or climbing on the branches as it is dangerous due to their large size. Also be careful when sitting or walking under branches as they can break without warning.
