Beach Lifeguards

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga.- Due to rising popularity, Gould's Inlet will have more patrols though Labor Day. Glynn County Fire Department personnel will be stationed at Gould's Inlet on weekends from 11am to 6pm as a part of their regular shifts.

Beginning Monday, August 13, 2018, Glynn County's beaches at Coast Guard Station and Massengale will not have stationed lifeguards on duty during weekdays. Many of the lifeguards are high school and college students who must return to school on or around August 9, 2018. A reduced number of lifeguards will be on duty the week of August 6-10, 2018, from 11a.m. to 6 p.m. Lifeguards will also be on duty each weekend through September 2, 2018, and Labor Day, from 11:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Glynn County Recreation and Parks employees who are certified lifeguards will also patrol East Beach on the weekends of September 15-16 and 29-30, 2018, for four hours during the daytime high tide cycle.

When lifeguards are on duty, look for the beach warning flags attached to the guard stands. While caution should always be exercised in the water, red and yellow flags warn of strong or moderate currents and surf. Remember that the absence of flags, does not assure that the water is safe.
