Glynn County and Consultant to host Open House

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga.- Glynn County and its consultant, Applied Technology and Management, Inc. (ATM), will host an open house on Monday, March 11, 2019, from 4:00 pm to 6:00 pm in Room 108 of the Casino (550 Beachview Dr., St. Simons Island) to discuss and receive public input on the upcoming shoreline improvement project. ATM is providing engineering and permitting services utilizing a \$2.5 million grant issued by the OneGeorgia Authority, the funding mechanism for the Georgia Department of Community Affairs, to restore and increase the resiliency of the St. Simons Island shorelines following damages caused by Hurricanes Matthew and Irma. Grant funds may be used for necessary studies, planning/consulting/engineering activities, obtaining necessary state and/or federal permits, location-appropriate natural vegetation necessary to maintain dunes, construction/reconstruction of dunes, installation/maintenance of rock revetments, or other activities deemed appropriate by the OneGeorgia Authority.

ATM conducted an initial analysis of the St. Simons shoreline and recommends focusing on the rehabilitation of the existing rock revetment along specific portions of the beach due to grant funding and timeline restrictions. The goal is to improve storm protection by prioritizing locations where the revetment is deficient or dysfunctional and threatens public infrastructure. Citizens are invited to attend the open house to gain a better understanding of the scope of the project and provide input or personal insight.
