March 13, 2018

Board Minutes

The meeting of the Board of Elections was called to order by Chairman Robinson at 10:00 a.m.

Present were Ruby Robinson, Chairman; Tommy Clark, Vice Chairman; Patricia Gibson, Secretary; Sandy Dean, Member; Keith Rustin, Member; Monica Couch, Supervisor; Christopher Channell, Assistant Supervisor; Taylor Cooper, guest; Pamela Permar-Shierling, guest.

Approval of Minutes of February 13, 2018 Regular Board Meeting

Mrs. Dean made a motion to approve the minutes from the February 13 Board Meeting. Mr. Rustin seconded the motion. Motion approved 5-0.

Supervisor's Office Report

Mrs. Couch presented the Cancelled/Deceased lists from February. The Board performed a brief review of the names as presented.

Mrs. Couch went over the final Precinct Polling Locations for 2018. Temporary polling locations of Fire Station #2 for St. Williams precinct and Zion Baptist Church for Burroughs Molette have been established. A permanent polling location will move from Glyndale Elementary to Blythe Island Baptist Church, which is in the precinct boundary. A permanent polling location will move from Abundant Life Church to The Chapel. Precinct cards have been ordered and have been mailed to those affected. Mrs. Couch will soon order signs to inform voters of the changes. Mrs. Couch is also considering putting at least one more ad in the paper prior to the election. Mr. Clark made a motion to approve the polling locations for 2018 as submitted. Mr. Rustin seconded the motion which passed 5-0.

Mrs. Couch went over the Qualifying from last week. It was noted that one of the Candidates that was qualified by their party did not meet the residency requirement. After a brief discussion, Mr. Clark made a motion that the Glynn County Board of Elections challenges the qualification of Vicki Greene due to her residing outside the commission boundary. The motion was seconded by Mrs. Dean and the motion passed 5-0. A letter will be sent to Mrs. Greene informing her of the Board's action and a hearing will be set to determine her status on the ballot.

A request was made by Mrs. Gibson for a copy of the straw poll questions as submitted by each party. Once the list has been compiled, a copy will be sent to the Board members.

Mrs. Couch presented the Board with a comparison from other Counties in the State including what their staffing levels and budget authority is. After a discussion, Mr. Clark made a motion that the Board compose a letter with the justifications and documentation supporting the need for the added Full-time position. Mr. Rustin seconded the motion. After it was determined that

once the letter was composed, it would be sent to the Board members for their approval. The motion to send a letter to the Board of County Commissioners was approved 5-0.

Mrs. Couch reminded the board of the upcoming GEOA/VRAG Conference. The conference will be March 25-28 in Athens, GA.

Future Agenda Items

Mrs. Dean would like to review the By-Laws as they pertain to evaluation for the Supervisor.

Adjournment

Mrs. Dean made a motion to adjourn, Mr. Clark seconded the motion. Motion approved 5-0. Meeting adjourned at 10:39 a.m.
