Hurricane Dorian Update #3

GLYNN COUNTY, Ga.- The forecasted track of Hurricane Dorian has moved to the East and could skirt the Georgia coast. If this track continues, Glynn County will likely see tropical storm force winds on the immediate coastal area and greater impacts from storm surge and rain. This storm has been unpredictable and at this time the earliest possible effects from the storm could be experienced on Monday, September 2, 2019.

A coastal flooding advisory still applies. There are currently seasonally high tides and flooding is an issue due to storm surge and rain. This track could potentially cause over 5 inches of rain through Thursday in an area that is already soaked with rain from the current Nor'easter. The storm is currently causing hazardous marine conditions and rip currents.

Coastal Georgia is currently under a state of emergency. This declaration extends to commerce and the uninterrupted supply of petroleum products, emergency or disaster related materials, supplies, goods and services. **Glynn County has not declared a state of emergency.**

For non-emergency calls, please use 912-554-3645 to free up 911 lines for emergency calls. Glynn County Animal Control is offering free microchipping for pets from 12:00 -5:00 p.m. August 30-31, 2019, to aid in finding lost pets. Interstate 95 will likely see increased traffic as people move from the direct path of the hurricane.

There are no closures to announce at this time from the Glynn County School System, the City of Brunswick, Jekyll Island Authority, FLETC, Coastal Pines, Coastal College of Georgia, or Glynn County. We will continue to monitor conditions and updates will be available at www.glynncounty.org and on the Glynn County EMA Facebook daily at noon throughout the weekend. The Facebook video updates will continue next week. We advise the public to use the latest forecast models from the National Weather Service Jacksonville to stay informed between updates.
