

SAINT SIMONS MARINA
RULES AND REGULATIONS
Amended January 2019

The following rules and regulations have been adopted by the Saint Simons Marina Board of Directors governing the use of the Marina:

1. No smoking inside the dry storage building or within 50 feet of a boat being fueled. Batteries in dry storage boats must be off or disconnected.
2. No "rafting" to docked boats without prior approval of the marina manager.
3. Use of wash dollies is limited to two days unless prior approval of the marina manager is granted for longer use.
4. No storage of personal items on marina premises without prior approval of the marina Board of Directors.
5. The marina is for recreational boating only. No commercial activity is permitted on marina property.
6. Any member in default of any fees or charges for 60 days or more may not move his/her boat from the marina until such default is remedied. Membership and/or storage rights may be revoked at the discretion of the Board of Directors for habitual occurrences of non-payment.
7. All residue must be removed from the fish cleaning station after use.
8. Trailers for boats using marina facilities, to include wet slips (monthly & transit docks), dry storage or launches for day boating, are allowed to be parked on marina property for a maximum of 5 consecutive days. Boats and trailers not using marina facilities or trailers exceeding the 5 consecutive day limit and parked on marina property are subject to impound. Parked trailers may exceed the 5 consecutive day limit on a case-by-case basis and with the permission of the marina manager.
9. Management reserves the right to refuse launching and/or providing wet/dry storage due to the condition of the boat, trailer, dolly, lifting rings and other miscellaneous equipment.
10. Wet dockage is limited to boats with an overall length of 35 feet or less.
11. Hazardous conditions affecting the safety of marina property/personnel as determined by the Board of Directors or in exigent circumstances by the Marina manager, will

necessitate all boats to be removed from both the south and north docks. Such conditions will include but not be limited to named storms and/or hurricanes.

12. Dockside (wet storage) and dry storage maintenance is limited to normal, routine, periodic, and minor in nature. All maintenance must receive prior approval from marina manager. Extensive and major projects such as overhauls, restoration, rebuilding, upgrades, and replacements are prohibited. In the case of a questionable project, application must be submitted to the marina board of directors.
13. Due to operational necessity to include but not limited to emergency access, safety and fire concerns, members leasing storage space in the marina's dry storage facility will maintain their respective boats and accompanying dollies in operational condition.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO ABIDE BY THE NO-WAKE ZONE BEGINNING AT THE SOUTHERN END OF THE FREDERICA RIVER NEXT TO THE CONDOS AT THE GOLDEN ISLES MARINA CONTINUING NORTH TO EPWORTH BY THE SEA.
