NOTIFICATION TO ATTORNEY GENERAL


On January 21, 2021 Defendant Bryan filed a "Motion to Compel Lawful Appointment of Another District Attorney Pro Tempore to Succeed Joyette Holmes". The Motion claims, *inter alia*, that some ambiguity exists as to the appointment of the District Attorney Pro Tempore due fact that Attorney Joyette Holmes is no longer the Cobb County District Attorney. The Administrative Order appointing Ms. Holmes provides:

That under the authority contained in O.C.G.A. § 15-18-5, Joyette M. Holmes, District Attorney, Cobb Judicial Circuit or her designee, is hereby appointed to act as District Attorney Pro Tempore, Brunswick Judicial Circuit...

Administrative Order, Dated May 11, 2020 (Filed June 8, 2020).

Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 15-18-5(f), the undersigned NOTIFIES the Attorney General of the potential disqualifying factor in this case. The State is DIRECTED to forward a copy of this Order to the Office of the Attorney General of the State of Georgia for any appropriate action.
