### ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL:

WHEREAS: On February 27, 2020, the District Attorney for the Brunswick Judicial Circuit notified this office that she was recusing her office from the investigation and subsequent prosecution arising out of the death of Ahmaud Arbery; and

WHEREAS: Pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 15-18-5, this office appointed Cobb Judicial Circuit District Attorney Joyette Holmes or her designee to act as District Attorney Pro Tempore, Brunswick Judicial Circuit to prosecute in the name of the State the death investigation of Ahmaud Arbery on May 11, 2020; and

WHEREAS: On February 1, 2021, Superior Court Judge Timothy R. Walmsley issued an order invoking O.C.G.A. § 15-18-5(f), thus requiring an appointment under O.C.G.A. § 15-18-5(a).

NOW, THEREFORE, PURSUANT TO O.C.G.A. § 15-18-5, IT IS HEREBY

ORDERED: That Flynn Broady, Jr., the successor Cobb Judicial Circuit District Attorney, or his designee, was substituted for former District Attorney Joyette Holmes when he took office and is to continue to act as District Attorney Pro Tempore, Brunswick Judicial Circuit, to prosecute in the name of the State for the time period beginning from investigation and until all appeals are exhausted, the following case, to wit: Death investigation of Ahmaud Arbery and pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 15-18-5(c) shall receive no additional compensation for such services except that actual expenses incurred shall be reimbursed by Glynn County at the same rate as provided for district attorneys in O.C.G.A. § 15-18-12; and it is further

ORDERED: That this appointment remain with the District Attorney of the Cobb Judicial Circuit and that any subsequent District Attorney of the Cobb Judicial Circuit shall be substituted as the District Attorney Pro Tempore of the Brunswick Judicial Circuit in this case.
