



GLYNN COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS AND REGISTRATION

Work Session, Tuesday January 12, 2021

The Work Session of the Board of Elections and Registration was called to order by Chairman Gibson at p.m.

Present were Patricia Gibson, Chairman; Patricia Featherstone, Vice Chairman; Keith Rustin, Secretary; Christopher Channell, Supervisor; Christina Redden, Assistant Supervisor. Absent were Tommy Clark, Member; Sandy Dean, Member.

Presentation to County Commissioners

Ms. Redden presented a draft of the presentation intended to emphasize the critical space concerns and subsequent risks to elections security and transparency. The Board reviewed the presentation to provide editorial direction. The presentation is to include historical information explaining how the space crisis occurred, legislative space mandates such as public observation areas and secure storage, the goals for a new space, and a direct request for a new office location. Ms. Featherstone suggested design additions within the presentation to emphasize key points. Ms. Redden will revise the presentation based on Board input with Mr. Rustin's assistance. The final presentation will be presented on January 19.

Ms. Featherstone asked if the presentation should include the larger scope of the Board's space goals, specifically the challenges at Saint Simons Island and emergency contingencies. Different contingencies include voting at the Casino building, emergency building rentals, and mobile voting. Ms. Redden will explore these options and include them as part of the overall presentation.

Poll Worker Recognition

Ms. Gibson and Ms. Featherstone had worked together to develop a proposal for poll worker recognition. The Board determined the best method to reach all of the community is with a full page ad in *The Brunswick News*. Ms. Featherstone stated it would be important to finalize the ad soon in order to run in the Saturday paper by the end of January. Ms. Gibson commented it will be important to reach out to *The Islander* and other news outlets to ensure the message reaches the most people. Ms. Redden was tasked with contacting local broadcasters and advertisers. Ms. Featherstone will oversee the full-page ad project.
