

ORDER TO SEAL EVIDENCE

In open court, during a hearing outside the presence of the jury in the trial of this case, Defendant William R. Bryan tendered his Exhibits 7, 8, 9, 10, and 11 for the record, and requested that they be filed under seal. The State did not object. These exhibits are on a USB drive which contains: (1) an aerial photograph of the neighborhoods immediately surrounding courthouse with a pinpoint marker to the stated residence of Juror 380; (2) a photograph of the front of the Glynn County Courthouse with publicly visible security enhancements; (3) photographs reflecting side views of the Glynn County Courthouse with publicly visible special enhancements; (4) a photograph of the rear of the Glynn County Courthouse showing publicly visible specially security enhancements; and (5) a zoomed photograph taken within three blocks of the Glynn County Courthouse. The public interest in this document is substantially outweighed by the privacy interest of the exhibits. Accordingly, for good cause shown, the Clerk of Superior Court is hereby ordered to **SEAL Exhibits 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11** admitted for the record (but not admitted for publication to the jury) during the trial of this matter.
