
STATEMENT OF APPEAL

The following statement was read to the below named defendant after he was sentenced on \_\_\_\_\_.

“You are hereby notified that under the law of Georgia you are entitled to appeal the guilty verdict of the (jury) (court), and if you decide to do so, you must file your appeal within 30 days of this date.”

You are also informed that you have the right to retain a lawyer of your own choice to represent you on your post trial motions and appeals to the appropriate Appellate Court of Georgia. If you cannot afford a lawyer, the court will appoint one for you. You are entitled to and will be given a transcript of all pretrial, trial and post trial matters without cost to you if you cannot afford a transcript.

You may file a motion for a new trial or you may appeal your case directly to the appropriate Appellate Court of Georgia for review.
