



GLYNN COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS AND REGISTRATION

Meeting, Tuesday, July, 28, 2022

The July meeting of the Board of Elections and Registration was called to order at 11:00AM.

Present were Patricia Featherstone, Chairman; Keith Rustin, Vice-Chairman; Ward Schaumberg, Secretary; Sandy Dean, Member; Tommy Clark, Member; Christina Redden, Assistant Director

Call for Special Election- SPLOST 2022, November 8 2022

Ms. Redden introduced the SPLOST 2022 Resolution from the County Commissioners along with the ballot wording, the Notice of Special County One Percent Sales and Use Tax Election on November 8, and the Call for a Special Election. Mr. Clark and Mr. Schaumberg requested verification this special election will not need to be held on separate equipment or in separate locations as the general election. Ms. Redden verified SB202 was written so that all such referendum special elections will always be held on the same date and on the same equipment as a general election or general primary. Ms. Redden also explained how the question would be placed on the ballot and the impact on ballot printing. Mr. Rustin made the motion to call for a Special Election to be held on November 8, 2022 relative to the imposition of a special one percent sales and use tax as stated in the County Commissioners' SPLOST 2022 resolution. Ms. Dean seconded the motion. The motion passed 5-0.

Intergovernmental Agreement- Secretary of State Loaned Equipment

Ms. Redden presented the agreement to accept the Secretary of State's loaned equipment to meet the 250:1 ratio ahead of the general election. Ms. Redden explained previous revisions to the document from the State and County attorneys. Ms. Dean made the motion to accept the intergovernmental agreement and Mr. Schaumberg seconded. The motion passed 5-0. The Director will travel to the State warehouse in August to pickup the equipment.

Ms. Dean made the motion to adjourn, Mr. Clark seconded. The motion passed 5-0.
