Glynn County Animal Services Grand Opening

GLYNN COUNTY, GA – On Saturday, July 23, 2022, Glynn County Animal Services new home will be officially opened with a Grand Opening event for the public. The new Animal Services facility has been fully functional since October 2021, but due to COVID restrictions, an opening event was postponed. With the appointment of a new Division Manager, Lori Austin, the timing to host an event was right.

The Grand Opening will begin at 10AM with a ribbon cutting by staff and Glynn County Administration. A special message from First Lady Marty Kemp will be played on the video boards in the building. Family friendly festivities will begin afterwards with games, face painting, a picnic area, and other fun surprises. The public is encouraged to attend and to see the available animals up for adoption.

“We are happy to finally show off this new resource to the public,” said Austin. “We want them to see the new facility and be familiar with the services we offer them and the animals.”

Animal Services was previously housed on Highway 17. An updated building was listed as a SPLOST 16 project with construction starting in August 2020.
